Dr. Scott Turansky and Joanne Miller teach in a dialogue format that keeps people interested and learning in creative ways. Each one and a half hour session presents relevant solutions to the real problems parents face. They use drama, practical illustrations, and the scriptures as they teach principles that apply to traditional families as well as single parent and blended families. Turansky and Miller aren't interested in simply behavior modification but want to help children change their hearts as well. Their presentation is sensitive to non-believers making it a great outreach to the community.

Either a **Friday evening/Saturday morning seminar** or a **Saturday** from 9:00 am to 2:30 pm, offering several sessions. The following is a typical schedule.

Session #1 - Attitude: A Window into a Child's Heart

You see it. You don't like it. In fact, sometimes it makes you angry. Bad attitudes bring a stormy climate into any family. It's much easier to get kids to do the right thing than it is to get them to do it with a good attitude. This session is essential for any family where bad attitudes exist. You'll learn the three components of an attitude and then use these components to make deep and lasting changes.

Session #2 - Helping Children Deal with Anger

Some children can be highly emotional and even explosive, creating tension and unrest in family life. They need help to understand their anger and to develop a plan to keep their emotions in check. This session gives parents specific guidelines to help children deal with anger. Don't be surprised if you gain some important tips for managing your own anger as well.

Session #3 - Teaching Children to Accept No as an Answer

Everyone has to learn to live within limits and it's best when children learn it young. Accepting no as an answer teaches children the valuable heart-quality of contentment. Children have many manipulative techniques to challenge a no answer including, whining, badgering, and arguing. If you see these poor heart responses in your kids, this session will show you exactly what to do to bring about the change both you and your kids need.

The seminar is punctuated with drama in all sessions. Question and answer times provide parents with opportunities to present real problems they're facing and hear suggestions.

We end the seminar by talking about God's desire to touch the hearts of parents, not just their kids. Parents leave the seminar encouraged, armed with lots of practical strategies, and a new vision for touching the hearts of their children.
